ADDING AND SUBTRACTING DECIMALS

- When adding and subtracting decimals, the decimal points and each of the decimal places must be aligned under one another.
- The location of the decimal point in the answer is directly in line with the location of each of the decimal points in the question.
- Once the numbers are aligned correctly, proceed as if completing whole number addition or subtraction.
- If the numbers of decimal places in the numbers beings added or subtracted are different, it is helpful to place additional zeros in the shorter number(s) to prevent calculation errors.
